

Conditions of Entry for 'felt' 2018
An exhibition by Members of the Victorian Feltmakers Inc

1. **felt 2018** will be held at **Town Hall Gallery, 360 Burwood Rd, Hawthorn July 3rd – July 29th 2018**

A special Opening event will be held **2-4pm, Saturday July 7th 2018**.

2. This will be a curated exhibition as part of the conditions of Gallery. The Gallery Curator will have the final decision on entries. This exhibition is open to members of the Victorian Feltmakers Inc. (VFI)

3. Opening hours for Town Hall Gallery, Community Project Wall: Monday to Friday 10 am – 5 pm. Saturday & Sunday: 11am – 4pm.

4. The Gallery does not provide insurance for works so any insurance cover is the responsibility of the entrant.

Please understand that although all care will be taken with entries, any theft or damage will not be the responsibility of the VFI or its members.

5. Up to two works may be submitted. If space permits both will be exhibited.

6. Only one entry form needs to be submitted. Please submit photos of the work attached to the form with name, title and dimensions listed on the back.

7. Each item must be labeled with its title and the artist's name.

8. Wall hangings and framed work must be submitted with appropriate hardware attached, ready to hang.

9. Framed or fragile pieces must be submitted in an appropriately labeled box or padded bag.

10. Work may be priced to sell including a 15% commission which will be claimed by the Gallery.

11. If work is submitted by a member who lives further than 70km from Melbourne's CBD, the VFI committee will organize postal return free of charge. Collection time/date will be confirmed when items are dropped off. Members are encourage to collect work on Sunday 10-12.00 am July 29th. Unclaimed work will be brought to the VFI general meeting August Saturday 11th. If work is not collected from that meeting, you must contact Di 0408 107 993 or Genielle 9761 2373 to negotiate collection.

12. Entrants grant permission for VFI to photograph entries and publish them in articles, ads, promotions, catalogues, books, websites, CD's, current event news coverage and/or multimedia productions for and about VFI. VFI respects the fact that the artwork copyright remains with the artist.

13. Submitted work will have been created within the past three years and shall not have been exhibited at a previous VFI exhibition.

14. Submitted work will be original and not copied verbatim from a publication. Inspirational design sources should be acknowledged.

15. If work was created in a workshop or class, the tutor and class must be acknowledged.
